Parents/Guardians will;	
<p>Set a good example at all times within the clubs philosophy</p> <p>Encourage players to play by the laws of the game</p> <p>Not criticise mistakes (players need to be encouraged to learn by trying things in the game and a fear of failure will stifle creativity)</p> <p>Support and encourage all players, including the opposition</p> <p>Never publicly criticise players (including their own)</p> <p>Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities</p> <p>Will not question or criticise decisions made by the officials</p> <p>Show respect to coaches, officials/linesmen and administrators (without them, players could not participate).</p>	<p>Recognise that the coaching staff are following a long term Program of Development, as set out by The Junior Technical Director, with the player.</p> <p>Praise effort to help develop the player's intrinsic motivation</p> <p>Focus on performance (the style of play) and player development rather than winning or losing</p> <p>Not coach from the side-line (the only information given to the players should come from the coach)</p> <p>Discuss any concerns about the player's welfare and development with the Junior Technical Director or Junior Coordinator</p> <p>Will not criticise the club or club officials on social media</p> <p>Will not publish on social media photo's without consent</p>
